## IASA MEMBERSHIP CARDS

1. All players must be registered members of IASA and also must have IASA membership cards in order to be eligible to play.
2. A temporary membership can be purchased and is good for 1 season.
3. A yearly membership can be purchased for \$20.00 and is good for one year from date of purchase.
4. Players cards are due BEFORE the game starts in order to be placed in the line-up. Players without a membership card will not be placed on the line-up at all.
5. Replacement cards can be purchased if lost or stolen for \$5.00.
6. Once an IASA card has been purchased, individual statistics can be viewed on line at <http://members.arenasoftball.com>
7. All IASA must comply with all IASA rules as well as any Arena Softball facility rules.

# Team Roster Rules

1. A starting roster is due when the application is turned in.
2. Rosters will be frozen once the 6<sup>th</sup> game of the season has started.
3. All players must be IASA members.
4. To be eligible to play in playoffs a player must have played 2 full games before the 6<sup>th</sup> game.
5. A maximum of 15 players may be on the roster.
6. Players on the roster may not be removed until the conclusion of the season.
7. If a player plays for two teams they will forfeit the right to play for any team in that league and will be suspended.
8. All players must bat.
9. Anyone playing for a team is automatically added to the roster.



# Summary of New Rules

1. If a team forfeits during league play they will not be eligible for playoffs.
2. All player cards must be present during all games.
3. Any team using a player that has not checked in will forfeit that game.
4. If a player of a team has been checked in but is not present at game time, the captain of that team may be suspended and possibly forfeit that game.
5. For each female player missing out of the stipulated 4, during coed play, the opposing team will be awarded 10 runs prior to the start of the game. The penalized team must also sit a male on defense for the entire game. If a second female is missing at game time, an additional 10 runs will be awarded prior to the start of the game and an additional male must sit on defense the entire game.
6. All players must be checked in prior to stepping on the field.
7. A coed team will forfeit if at any time they have less than 2 females.
8. If a female player leaves (giving that team less than 4 females) at any point in a game a male player must sit on defense and 3 runs will be given to the other team every offensive inning she is not present.

10. The pitch trajectory is 5ft to 13ft

# Sportsmanship

Arena Softball is interested in ensuring that a high level of sportsmanship be maintained in its leagues and activities. Remember that our leagues are for leisure. Your “fun” is not to be at the expense of others. Please remember that open containers are not allowed in the dugout and that children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the dugout areas.

## Managers/ Team Captains Duties

1. Please be sure to read everything. If you should have any questions, please ask.
2. Make sure that we have your correct e-mail, mailing address and phone number that you can be reached at.
3. Make sure that if you need any special dates or times arranged for your schedule that you write it on your League Application.
4. Know the playing rules and inform members of your team.
5. Make sure that you let your players know that you are the only one that can dispute any calls. Your players can be ejected without warning if they argue any calls.
6. You are responsible for your teams conduct at and around the arena, whether they are playing or not. The league will not tolerate irresponsible acts.
7. Arena Softball will post schedules and standings online and at designated areas in the facility, please check routinely to check for any schedule changes. For online schedules and standings visit [www.arenasoftball.com](http://www.arenasoftball.com)
8. It is your responsibility to pass along any information given to you via e-mails, telephone or paper notices, to your players and fans.
9. Know the eligibility requirements and consequences.
10. As stated in the rule book, a team is guaranteed 50 minutes from official game start time to play a 4-inning game.
